

Community Foundation of Monroe County celebrated the completion of the Access to Recreation grant projects from the Kellogg Foundation with the opening of the River Raisin Heritage Trail.

The Community Foundation of Monroe County Board of Directors was pleased to announce the official opening of the "River Raisin Heritage Trail". The trail connects the City of Monroe with the State Park. This project is a culmination of a series of projects completed through a \$280,000 grant from the Kellogg Foundation. Other projects are: Playscape at Monroe Township Park, Sensory Garden at Veteran's Park and increased accessibility at the Navarre Anderson Trading Post. The Access to Recreation Initiative is targeted to provide universal access for all people, of all abilities, to enjoy Monroe's recreational, historic and cultural assets without restrictions.

The Monroe County Access to Recreation Project seeks to change the face of recreation in Monroe County forever. The four completed projects welcome people with mobility, vision, hearing, and cognitive disabilities. People of all ages and abilities deserve to enjoy their friends and families at play.

In addition, the Kellogg Foundation matched funds raised by the Community Foundation to create an endowment for a total of \$210,000. Projects eligible for funding from the endowment will include maintenance of the current projects and new construction or modification to other non-profit recreational sites in Monroe County, expanding universally accessible recreation.

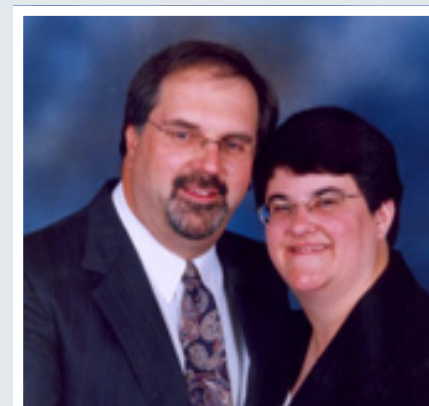

The grant seeker will be asked to complete a formal grant application and provide additional reference material. Please note: The Distribution Committee meets four times each year. In order for your request to be considered, it must be received by the Community Foundation of Monroe County by the 15th day of January, April, July or October. The Distribution Committee is on the first Tuesday of February, May, August and November. After review by the Distribution Committee, final decisions will be made by the Board of Trustees at their meeting, which is held on the 4th Wednesday of each month except December.
